Dear Senior Commander,

Choice Christian greetings!

As many outposts restart after slowing down or stopping altogether for the summer, we are entering the chartering season. Now is a great time to be getting your charter application together. Please note that it is our national and district policy that all outposts must charter in order to be considered a Royal Rangers outpost.

The SNED chartering period is January 1st to December 31st 2008. It is very important to get ALL outpost charters in on time. **All charters are due by January 15, 2008.**

Charter fees are unchanged from last year and are:

Boys:	\$12.00
Leaders:	\$15.00

Avoid late fees by chartering before January 15th, 2006. The late fee schedule is as follows:

Charters received after January 15th, please add \$25.00 to the total.
Charters received after April 15th, please add \$50.00 to the total.

There are numerous benefits to chartering:

- It's the right thing to do!
- Get plugged in! Being a Royal Rangers outpost, you are part of a sectional, district, regional, and national organization with resources to provide training and events for your leaders and boys.
- Materials like High Adventure magazine, membership cards and other materials to motivate your boys.
- A campsite at the Farm. Only chartered outposts may use this facility.

What forms to use?

Church Affiliation	Forms to Complete
Assemblies of God	A and D
PCCNA	B and D
Other (non-A/G, non-PCCNA)	C and D

Items that may hold up the charter renewal process:

- The signature of your senior pastor is required.
- The name, address, phone and email (if applicable) of Department Head and Senior Commander must be entered on Form A, B, or C.
- The name, address, phone and email (if applicable) of each age group Commander must be entered on Form D.
- A church check payable to "SNED Royal Rangers" must accompany the charter forms.

We make copies of your forms so please print clearly using black ink.
